- Experience with public sector employment law, including civil service and collective bargaining agreements.
- Experience in training and/or educating adults.
- Comfortable with public speaking and presentation to groups.
- Flexible, self-directed, and capable of simultaneously managing different projects in varying stages of development.

- Working knowledge of common business technology, such as Windows, Office 365, MS Word, MS Excel, and Google Docs.
- Access to reliable internet when working from home.
- Access to reliable transportation and the ability to travel to on-site testing locations for daytime and/or overnight stays up to four times a month.

This position will be a hybrid work schedule position, mainly working remotely. Occasional work at our corporate office in Lynnwood is helpful to prepare for test events but is not required. Travel around the Pacific Northwest to deliver test events is necessary on average 1 to 4 times per month. It is also required that applicants be able to lift boxes filled with equipment (up to 40 lbs.) and move multiple boxes on a wheeled cart. Significant indoor walking may be required on test days.
